On behalf of the Cowlitz and Wahkiakum Conservation District Boards of Supervisors, I would like to invite you to participate in a field tour featuring District projects in Wahkiakum County on Tuesday May 13 from 1-6 p.m.

We plan to visit sites in the Skamokawa Creek watershed and look at projects implemented through a variety of program and funding mechanisms, different resource concerns with different land uses, and highlight a variety of partnerships.

Our current plans are to visit the following project areas as we travel the watersheds from Cowlitz County to Wahkiakum County.

- 12:45 p.m. – Board buses: Red Lion, Kelso WA
- 2:00 p.m. – Arrive: Historic Skamokawa Creek outlet structure, overview of Historic Skamokawa Creek inlet structure (from bus)
- 3:00 p.m. – Crep (drive by), Fritsch project stop
- 4:30 p.m. – Crippen Creek Inn/Bed and Breakfast, Speranza 10 year old site: Coffee and cookie break (yum!)
- 6:00 p.m. – Return: Red Lion, Kelso WA

Each site is fairly accessible, but comfortable walking shoes are recommended. As always be prepared for NW weather!

The field tour will be followed by a no-host interactive dinner meeting with the Conservation Commission at the Red Lion located in Kelso at 6:15 p.m.
