Description

The Okanogan Conservation District is seeking a motivated, outgoing, and dynamic individual to fill a Conservation Educator position. The primary responsibility for this position is the delivery of K-12 science enrichment programs with a conservation focus. In addition to school programs, the position will also work on public communication projects including quarterly newsletters, social media and web presence, and in-person outreach at local events.

Applicants should have strong understanding of natural resource and conservation principles, and demonstrate the ability to communicate these principles to diverse ages and audiences, particularly K-12 students and their teachers. A bachelor's degree or higher in education, natural resources, natural sciences, or a related field is highly preferred. Experience may be substituted year for year for education. Bilingual English/Spanish skills are highly desirable but not required.

The Okanogan Conservation District is a dynamic organization comprised of volunteer board members and paid staff members that are leaders in "on-the-ground conservation". This position will work closely with other District and partner agency staff, and local landowners.

We seek individuals that will complement our highly productive, energetic, and skilled staff to deliver quality conservation education programs to Okanogan County residents.

Wages and Benefits
